On Friday afternoon & evening we'll be in Milford Towers.

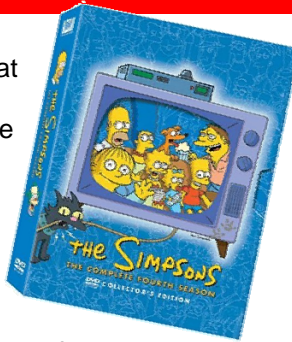
