1 Timothy 1:3-11

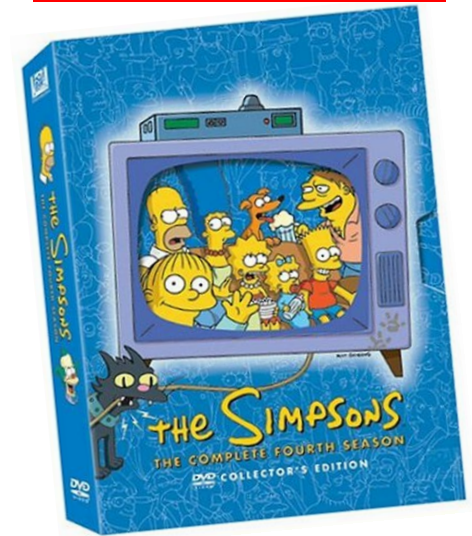
