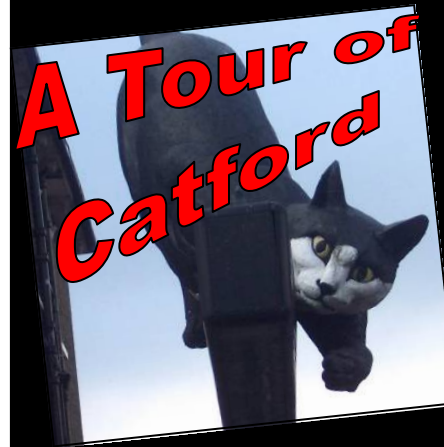

## Thai trip.

Fiona, Richard and I are going to Thailand tonight! We leave at 8.40pm and arrive in Bangkok on Monday evening (their time).

We will be staying with Richard and Bee Glazier and their family for 2 weeks, helping and supporting them in the work they do as part of The Wells Trust.

The Trust's purpose is to *"love Thai bar girls and sex workers in the same way that Jesus loved the woman at the well and others like her; to help her see and experience her true value as a creation by God, and to help her, her family and village indeed find their dream of a better life. The Well provides counselling, training, job development and other services to women and their family members."*



We will be helping run bible studies with the girls, and will be looking at the work the girls are given to do by the Trust, such as making jewellery. Other than that we're not exactly sure what we'll be getting up to, but I'm sure it will be very challenging but also rewarding.

I'd love it if you'd pray for us over the next couple of weeks. Here are a few things:

- d Safety - things seem to have calmed down in Bangkok now, the rioting has stopped and the violence has died down, and we'd like it to stay that way! Also safety travelling to, from and during our stay.
- d We want to be a help and not a hindrance to Richard and Bee and really want to bless them as a family.

d It's my first time abroad (I'm jumping in the deep end!) and I want it to be a good experience!
