## CCC Christmas Hampers

Last Christmas, we were delighted to be able to give several large hampers to destitute and at risk families. Thanks to everyone who contributed - Charlotte Wilson deliver the hampers to people she works with at the Family Action, Newpin Project.

Well, we'd love to do the same this year! We already know of at least 5 families who are in desperate need - two of these families have carers with severe mental health issues, one family is sofa surfing as they cannot afford anywhere to live, and one carer is a victim of domestic violence. All of them are far from home with no access to help, no support from family and friends and have been refused any financial help

These are the hidden poor which many of us do not meet, but of course they are not hidden from God.

So Gaynor and myself with help from Carol and Joyce are putting some hampers together this year. It would be great if as many as possible could contribute towards this, so please speak to me this morning, or email: [jo@catfordonline.org.uk](mailto:jo@catfordonline.org.uk)

If you want ideas of what to contribute we need dried foods (lentils, beans, etc), tinned food (no beans or meat), washing up and household goods. Many of these families have a Muslim background so we need to be sensitive and no champagne filled mince pies or Christmas cake. Mainly goods that will keep a family going for a month or two.

There's a box at the Point to collect items in, or money would enable us to buy any missing items. We need to get cracking as we hope to be able to give these hampers out by the end of the first week in December.
