"One week ago today, the Turkey team - Ian, Liz, Sam, Jamie, Phillippa and Jane - flew out to Istanbul to spend the week with our friends "S" and "T".



Our first night was spent in Iznik (the Nica of the New Testament, although there are no known believers there now) where we met with some Muslim friends.

One lady was very open and allowed us to pray for her. We also visited a village school where the staff and children were incredibly welcoming and proud of their school, and the teachers we met were enthusiastic about future contact.

Back in Istanbul we took in the sights-the bazaars, the Blue Mosque and the Hagia Sophia-and prayed for the city in various strategic places.

One highlight was meeting and praying with a Kurdish believer who has to keep his faith secret for fear of reprisals.

We all felt humbled and challenged by the hospitality of the Turkish people we met, and it was a privilege to share in our friends' life for a short time and add our prayers to theirs for their beautiful city."

Four goal Jordan seals the rout

Four goals for striker Jordan, a brace from Charlie and a goal each for Joel, Kamal and Lewis gave Catford a 9-2 victory against struggling Christ Church at Petts Wood yesterday

Despite missing Nyakeh and Eva from the heart of midfield, we got off to a great start with two goals from Jordan within the first three minutes, both from close range

We were never really challenged in the first half, and before the break there was time for goals from Joel and Kamal, before Jordan completed a hat-trick just before half time.

After half time the goals continued pouring in, (as did the rain). Charlie, who was unlucky not to score in the first half, bagged one for himself, and Lewis also scored from close range, Charlie got another but the goal that put the icing on the cake came from Jordan.

A cross from the right landed at the feet of the midfielder who, with his back to goal, swivelled and smashed it into the net on the half volley, an excellent finish well applauded on the touchline.

Christ Church scored a couple of consolation goals but this emphatic result was never in doubt, as we continue our solid start to the season. We now have 7 points out of a possible 12, and we'll be looking to be high in the league come the end of April.
