Fairtrade Helping Children in South Africa get Back to School!

Pupils at Klip Island Primary School in South Africa received school-bags paid for with the Fairtrade premium from Traidcraft raisins, which are also in Geobars.

They used to use plastic carrier bags to carry their books, which got damaged in the rainy season.

Head Teacher Rosy Visagie said: "I think the children will learn more now they have got a back-pack they can put their books in because now they can take their books home. The books got damaged when it was wet."

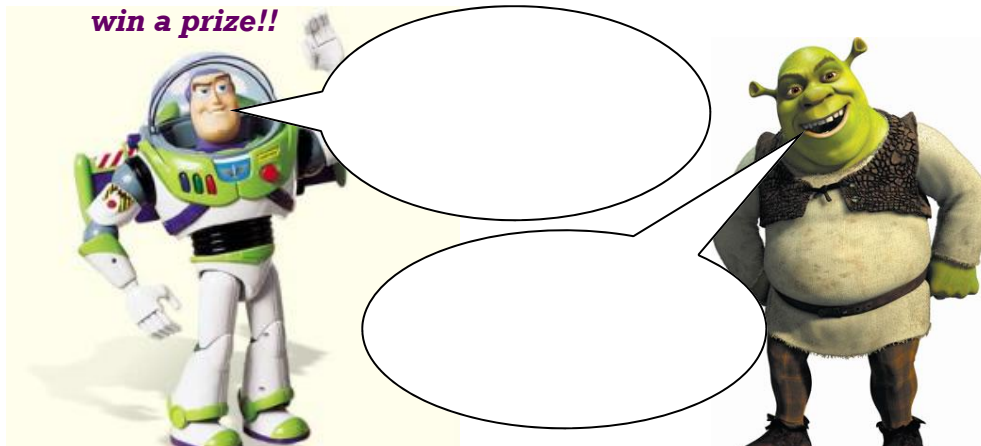
