## Street Pastors

The work of Street Pastors has proved to be significant in helping to bring peace and compassion to our streets, particularly late at night. Started in 2003, there are now 240 active Street Pastor groups in the UK and over 9,000 trained Street Pastors.

Street Pastors was born in South East London, and Lewisham was the 3<sup>rd</sup> borough in which the project was established. Very recently Street Pastors made a major contribution in bringing peace and order to the streets at the time of the riots.
