- there was a picture of God having brought us to the top of a hill, which has been a struggle to climb, but that now things can take off as the road gets easier.
- there was an encouragement to 'Put Jesus at the centre' - of our worship, our churches, and our lives - and to actively work out what this means in practice as well as saying it in principle!

The week ends this evening with the celebration at Malham Christian Centre at 7pm. There will be plenty of time to worship and hear from God together, and Denis Wade from Micah Ministries will be speaking - see you there!
