

Following St. Vaast

Will you follow in the footsteps of St Vaast and pray that spiritual wells will be reopened?

Spiritual mentor to the newly converted Franc King Clovis, St Vaast was appointed the first bishop of spiritually barren Arras in northern France in

499 AD. An evangelist with a strong healing anointing, St Vaast is recorded to have healed a blind man and a cripple on arrival at the main city gates. Over the following 40 years St Vaast planted numerous churches throughout the north of France and Belgium.

You're invited to join a 3 day prayer walk 5-7th May 2012, organized and run with the help of John and Yvonne Pressdee, who as leaders of Prayer Expeditions have led groups of Christians to prayer and walk more than 10,000 miles across the UK and Europe (for more info visit www.prayerexpeditions.org).

Routes will radiate out from Arras to various local areas associated with St Vaast, and will be between 10-14 miles each day. This is also an opportunity to walk and pray alongside local French protestant and catholic believers from Arras, as well as enjoy the local French countryside, experience Arras's charms and learn some local history.
